Stickers, New Milford Residents:

Valid: July 1 to June 30

Fee: RESIDENTS \$20.00

SMALL BUSINESS \$40.00

SENIORS (65+) FREE

Residents must show matching driver's license and registration to obtain a sticker. The sticker will be placed on the vehicle's windshield (lower left only!) at the time of issuance. New fees will apply on **July 1, 2016**. Thereafter, every car **MUST** have a sticker or the resident must buy a One Day Pass and the first sticker for SENIORS is FREE.

One Day Pass: \$3.00; good only for date of issuance

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

NO CASH! Checks OK

Punch Cards in amounts from 50¢ to \$32.00. Punch Cards may be purchased at the Center, Public Works Office, Town Clerk's Office and the Library. Purchase by credit card is available at the Public Works Office with a 2% service fee.

SMALL BUSINESS USE:

New Milford Businesses Only.

A "small business" is one that has no more than 2 principals and 10 employees. Small businesses are required to pay the Bulky waste fees, fees for specific items and \$0.10 per pound for recyclables. No MSW.

RECYCLABLES:

The Center uses "single-stream" recycling: all of your recyclables can be combined in one bag or bin.

Recyclables may be dropped off either loose or, if bagged, **ONLY** in clear or transparent blue bags.

No soft plastics like supermarket and pellet bags are allowed!

Below is a partial list of what can be recycled:

Most Plastics including toys and hangers

Glass: bottles, jars; food glass only

Cartons: milk, juice, cereal, egg

Cans: steel, tin, aluminum

Books: paperbacks, hardbound, phone

Cardboard: all types

Paper: bags, shredded, office, cards newspaper, computer, school, folders, magazines, inserts, junk mail

Aluminum foil

FREE TABLE

Center Personnel determine if an item may be placed on the Free Table and fees may apply, in their discretion. Parking is as directed by them. Use of the Table by metal scrappers and resellers is limited to one-half hour before closing. Use of the Table is a privilege, not a right, and the privilege may be revoked by Center personnel at any time.

The bucket on the loader is 1.5 CY and thus a full bucket is \$90.00 . The Center does not accept bulky waste such as dimensional lumber that is longer than 6 feet; sections of fencing must be no longer than 4 feet.
